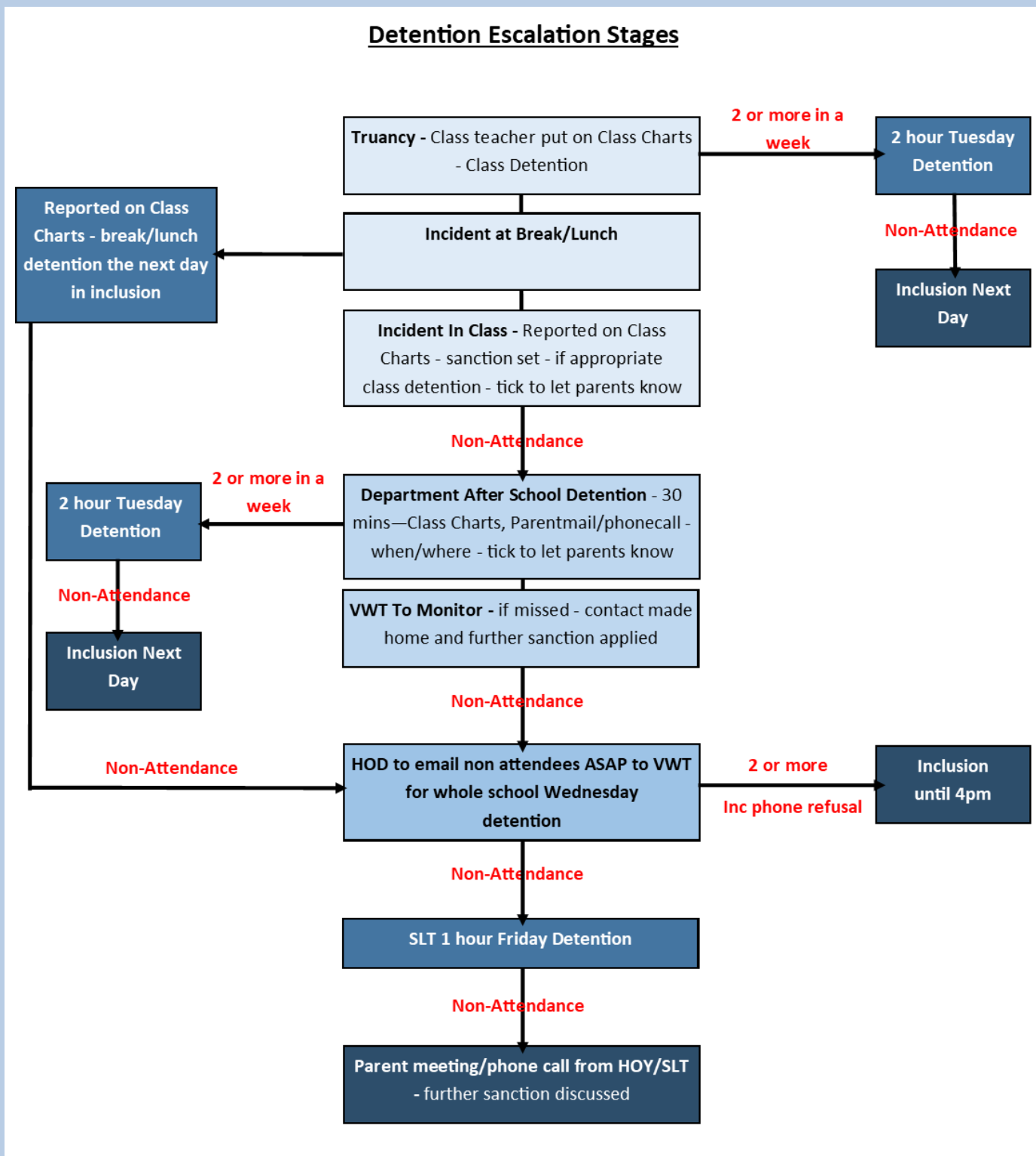

## Detention System

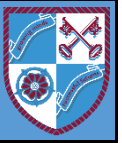
