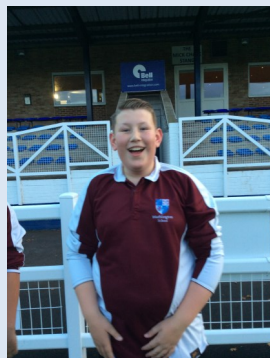
Sport Update W/B 04.11.19 Continued...

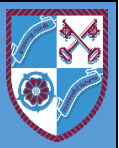
