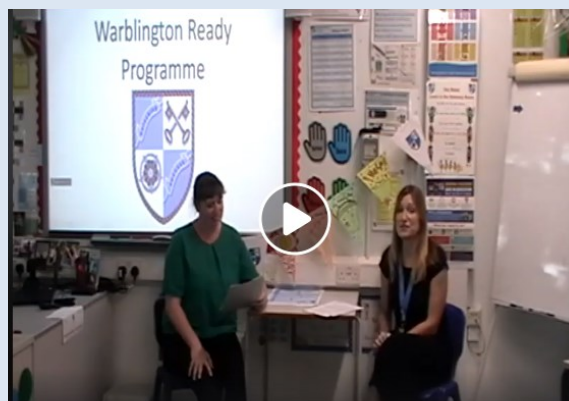

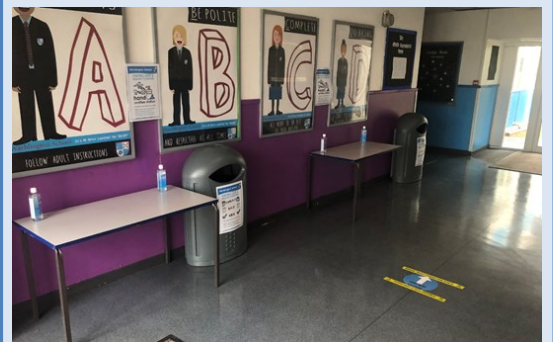

And the winner is... **SPANISH!**

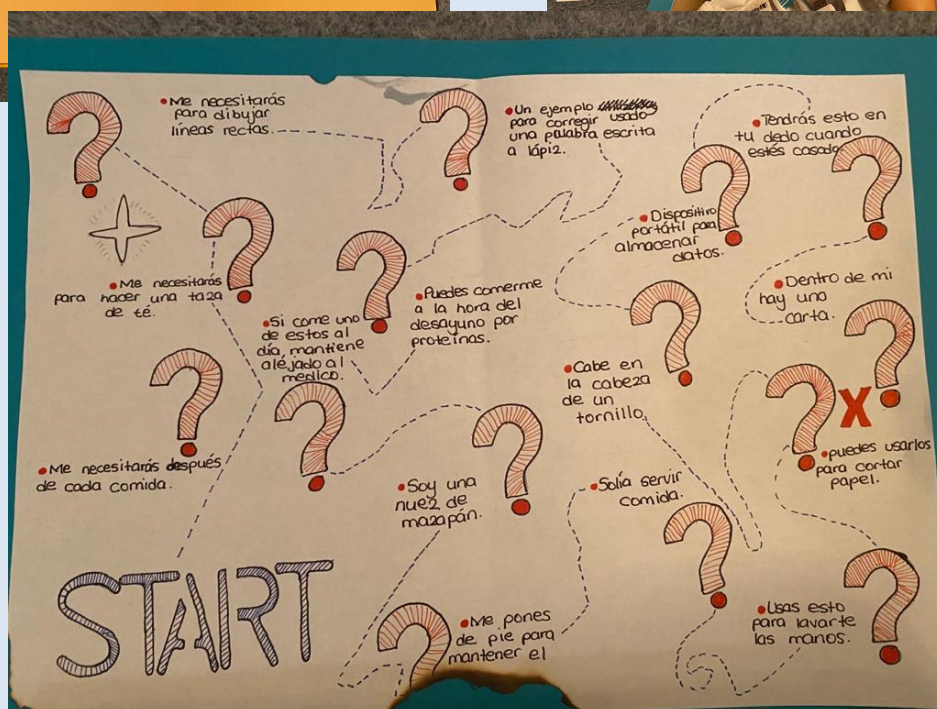
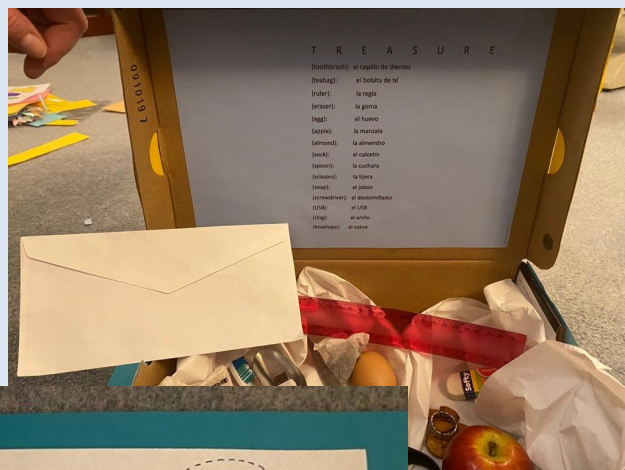
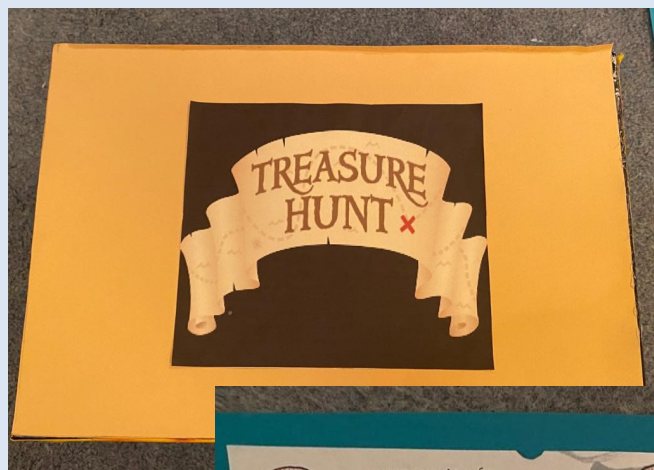
The MFL Treasure Hunt Rematch has finished and the scores are:
