## Attendance

- Students are expected to attend full time from September. The attendance line will be the way to contact us if students are feeling unwell and cannot attend.
- If anyone is experiencing any of these symptoms:

**When to self-isolate** (correct as of 20<sup>th</sup> July 2020)

The medical advice is clear: you must self-isolate if you have coronavirus symptoms or live in the same household as somebody who does. The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- **high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- **new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- loss or change to your sense of **smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

They are asked not to come onto site, and if already on site will be isolated immediately and asked to be collected.

- **For that reason, it is an essential health and safety measure that we have at least 3 mobile numbers to contact parents and carers.**







## Uniform

- All students **MUST** wear full school uniform from September.



## Equipment

- All students **MUST** bring their own equipment for all lessons – our Ready to Learn Pencil cases contain all that is required. This includes, in a Pencil case, 2 x Black Pens, Pencil, Highlighters, Eraser, Ruler, Calculator, Compass and Protractor.





## Equipment

- Where possible, we are asking students to come with colouring pencils
- **We are unable to provide/share equipment.**
- Students are asked to bring a 'Covid Kit' – Tissues, hand sanitiser, full water bottle (refillable)
- Class reading books are available in tutor time, but the **library will be unavailable for at least the first half term**, so students will need to bring a reading book
- Apron/old shirt/overalls for Art/Technology.
- PE lessons will be outside whenever possible so school branded hoodie/trackies/leggings in addition to the shorts and polo shirt are recommended.

## Catering

- We encourage all students to bring a packed lunch to reduce lunch queues
- The canteen will be offering a limited break/lunch time service
- There will be a designated outdoor space for each year group. In the event of wet weather, we will be using the main hall, gym and sports hall.

- All students and staff **will follow movement arrows and one-way systems around the school site**. All movement inside and outside the buildings will be along a designated route/path.
- Bells will be rung signifying when classes are to leave. Students must leave the rooms as instructed and walk continuously to their next lesson. **Stopping in corridors is not permitted**, toilets will not be open between lessons.
- All students will be instructed by the Teacher when they can safely leave the classroom.
- Corridors - students must follow all arrows and direction of travel keeping to the left-hand side of the corridor.





- **Toilets will be locked and only available with permission from the teacher** in lesson or during Year group specific break and lunch times. This will be logged to ensure cleaning can be carried out.
- Teachers will allow students to leave with a toilet card and this information will be recorded via our systems to monitor toilet usage and alert cleaning teams.



## Classroom Layout



- Classrooms will all have a similar feel to them and will look mostly like this:



- The yellow and black tape indicates 2m distance from the teacher to the students. We have called this the “Technical Area” akin to football managers areas. Staff are asked to remain in this area wherever possible.



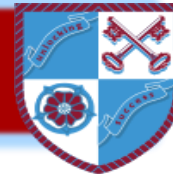
- All students **must sit in the seating plan**. This is an essential health and safety issue as we must be able to say who has sat within 2m should any infection happen.
- Music, IT and science are exceptions to facing the front. These classrooms will also have additional cleaning wipes / spray.
- Specialist equipment (eg paintbrushes) will be cleaned between lessons
- PE can continue, however there will be restrictions as to the sports that can be taught and surfaces in the changing rooms will be wiped between lessons. Lessons will be outside wherever possible. Classrooms are available for every lesson, and if required students will be told in tutor time that PE lessons will be classroom based for that day.
