As you maybe aware from September 2021 we are changing our school ties to individual House ties allowing students to proudly display what House they are in.


From Monday 28th June the ties will go on sale for pre-order via WEDUC for online payments only at the discounted price of £2 for our current Year 7-10 students.



The site does not ask you to provide any card information that will allow anyone to make a payment on your card - i.e. it does not ask for the card security code (CVC or CVV). 
