SUMMARY OF COURSE

Composition Study Unit (Internal)

Coursework submission evidence = Recording, Lead Sheet and Essay

You will be required to write a pop song set to a brief that shows good structure and development. **Music Knowledge Unit (Internal)**

Coursework submission evidence = 1500 word comparison genre essay and 1000 word essay song analysis.

You will study popular music culture and identify different genres / instruments / melodic & rhythmic devices.

External Unit: Live Music Performance (External)

Exam Evidence = Performance with support paper trial of preparation, rehearsals and evaluation. Students will be given an exam brief and must collectively create a concert/gig to show case their final performances that are suited to the exam brief. Students must perform for 10-12 minutes.
