#### Mussels Recipe

Moules marinière with cream, garlic and parsley

#### Ingredients

- 200g mussels (teacher to divide) 1 garlic clove, finely chopped 1 shallot, finely chopped 5g butter

- og butter
  50 ml white wine
  60 ml double cream handful of parsley leaves, coarsely chopped crusty bread, to serve
  Also serve with pasta (optional)

- Method
  Wash the mussels under plenty of cold, running water. Discard any open ones that
  won't close when lightly squeezed.
  Pull out the tough, fibrous beards protruding from between the tightly closed shells
  and then knock off any barnacles with a large knife. Give the mussels another quick
  rinse to remove any little pieces of shell (as you have watched on the videos by Rick
  Stein and Jamie Oliver).
  Peel and chop/dice the garlic and shallot. Soften the garlic and shallot in oil in a pan
- on a low neat.

  Add the mussels and wine to the pan, turn up the heat, then cover and steam them open in their own juices for 3-4 minutes. Give the pan a good shake every now and




