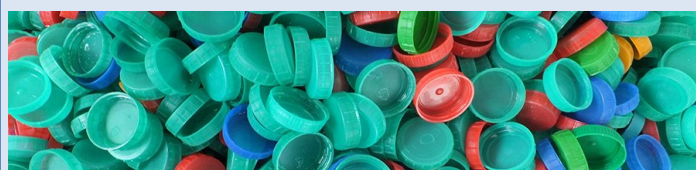
Milk Bottle Top Collection
