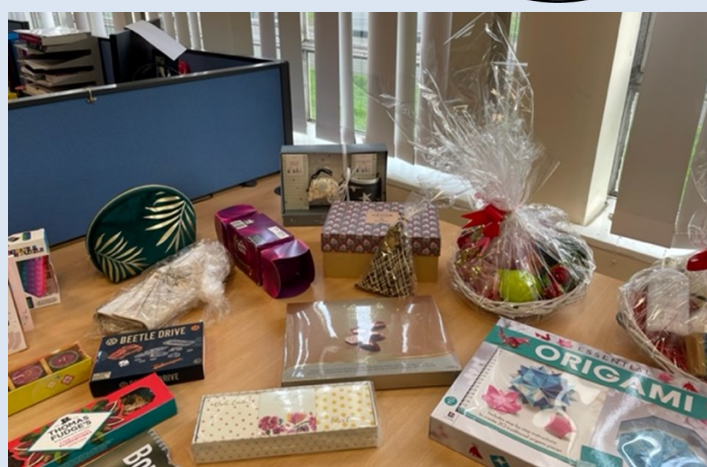
Eco Raffle

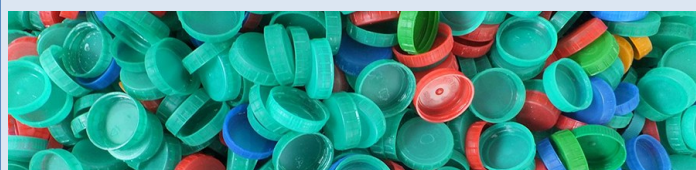
Milk Bottle Top Collection
