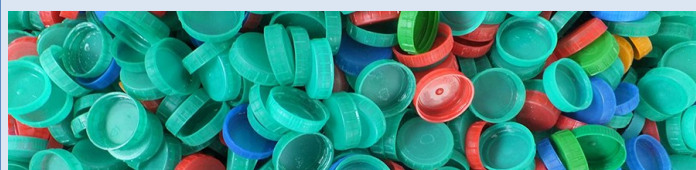
Milk Bottle Top Collection

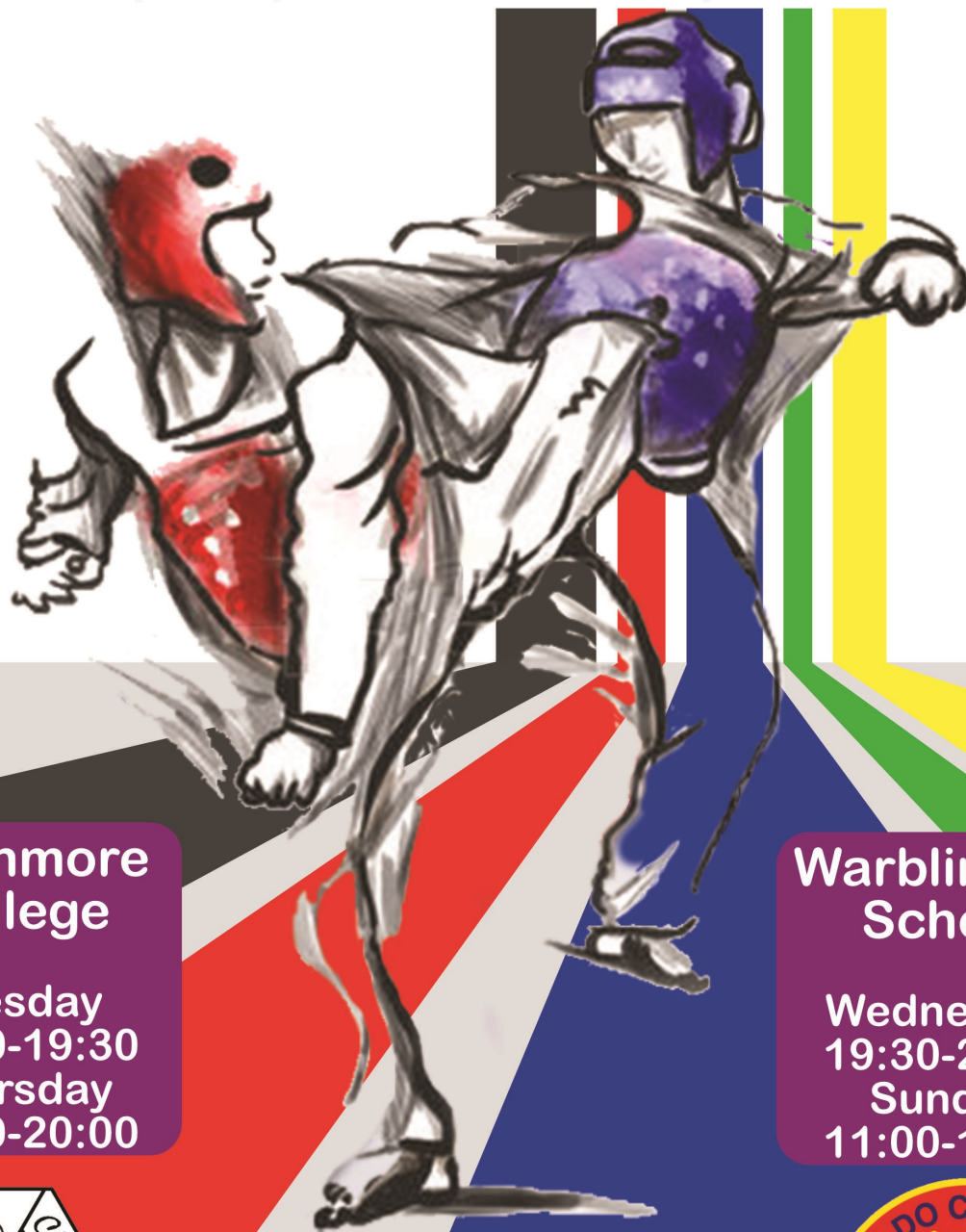

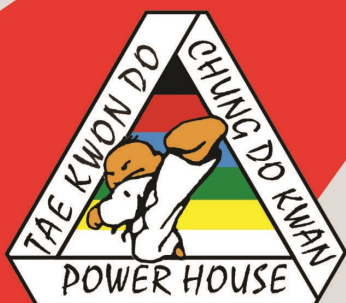
