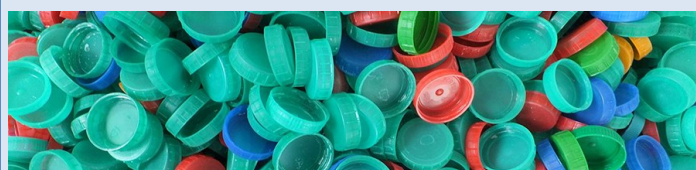
### Milk Bottle Top Collection
