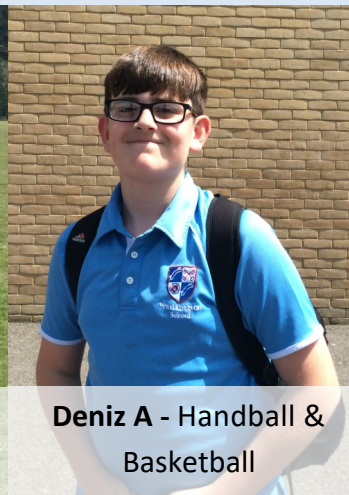

The event will take place during school time with students leaving the school grounds in groups accompanied by staff to complete one of two distances, 2 miles or 3 miles with the option to walk or run. The route incorporates the cycle path along the side of the school and the Hayling Billy cycle trail.

Students choose their distance and whether they want to walk or run. This event is not about what time you complete it in, it's about taking part, having fun and raising money and awareness. Our Race For Life is being supported by Cancer Research and everyone taking part will receive a t-shirt to decorate before hand and a medal on completion. Thank you!

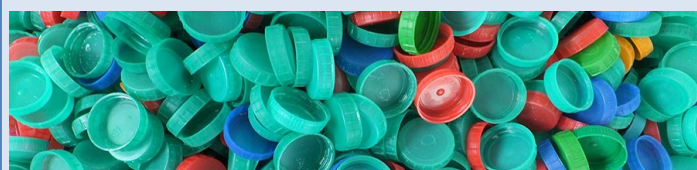
Milk Bottle Top Collection
