Cashless School

From September 2022 the school will move to a cashless school due to the high charges imposed by the bank. The cash loader in the dining hall will be turned off for cash payments from **Monday 18th July** and all lunch accounts will need to be topped up via WEDUC accounts. The biometric reader will remain in operation for students to check their balance. Parents can request a daily limit on students accounts which is currently set at £5.50 (cost of 2 meal deals). All trips will be required to be paid for on WEDUC when they arise. 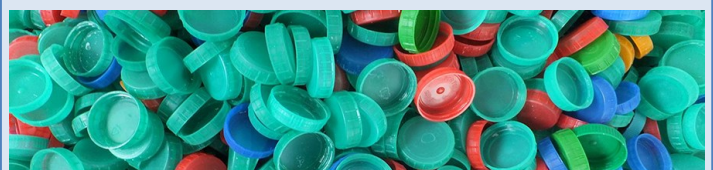
Milk Bottle Top Collection

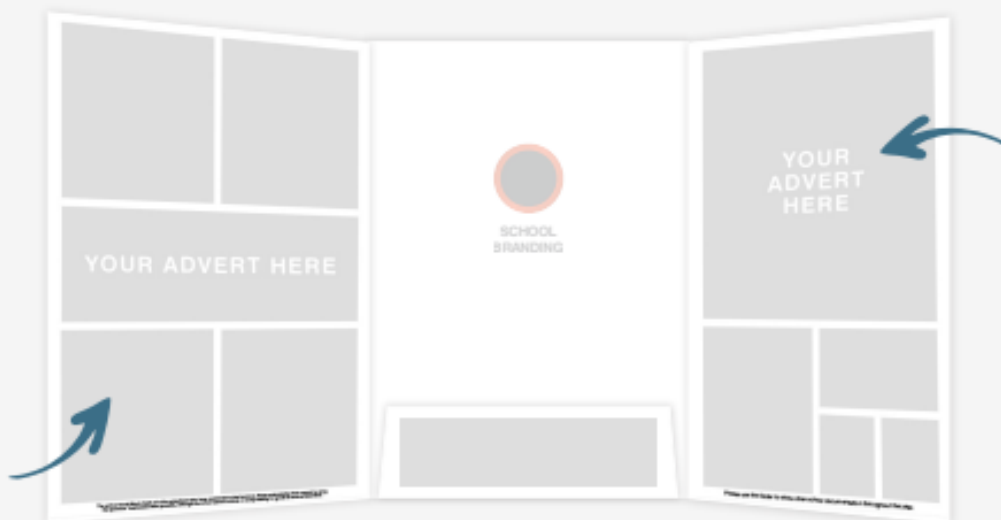
