The role of a school governor is to contribute to the work of the governing body in ensuring high standards of achievement for all children and young people in the school.

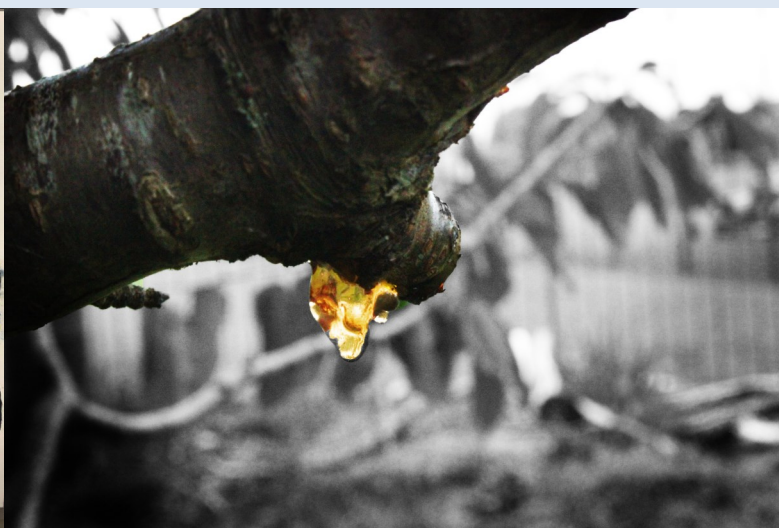

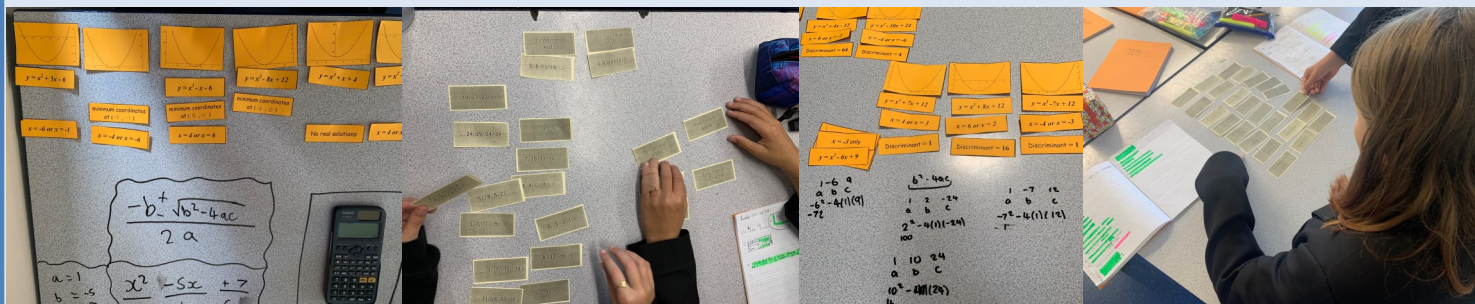

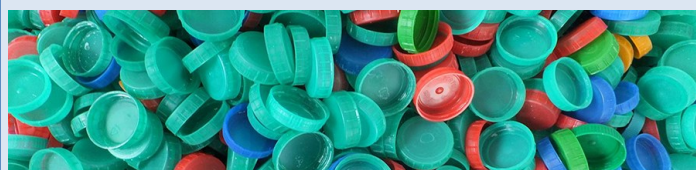
Milk Bottle Top Collection
