That person would kill the person to their left, and then pass the knife on.

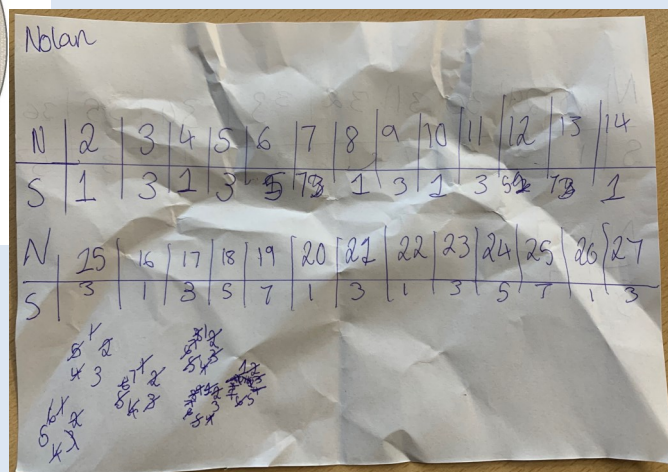
This would carry on, round and round the circle, until only one person was left. That person would surrender.

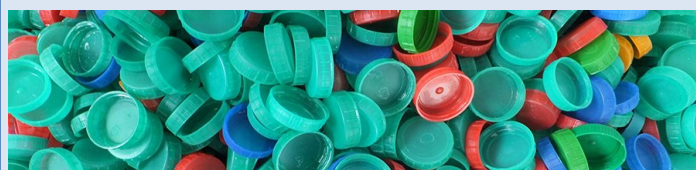
Milk Bottle Top Collection

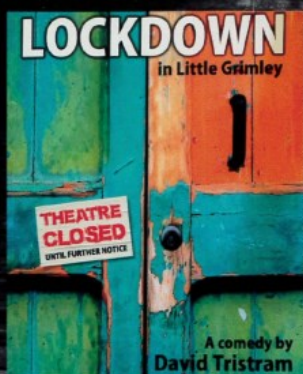

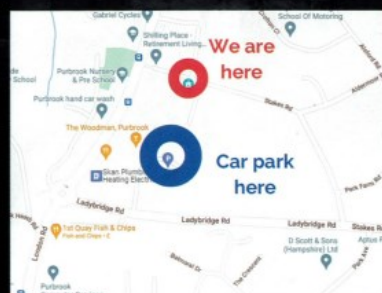
We were formed in 1962, and are therefore celebrating our 60th Anniversary. This will be our 97th production, and the 1st in our new home The Purbrook Centre.
