## Year 7 Art

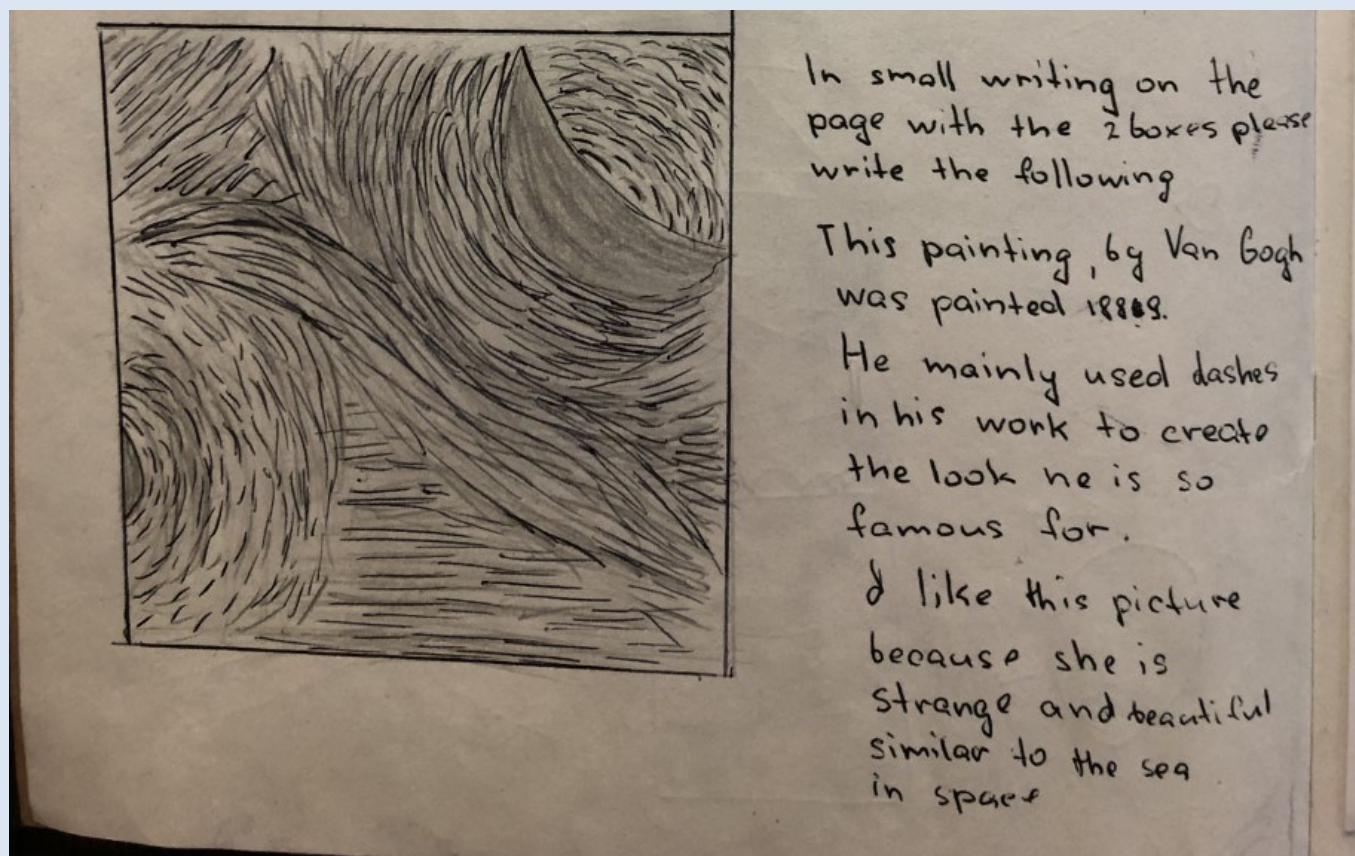
Year 7 have been studying the painting 'The Starry Night' by Vincent Van Gogh.

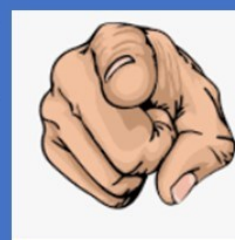

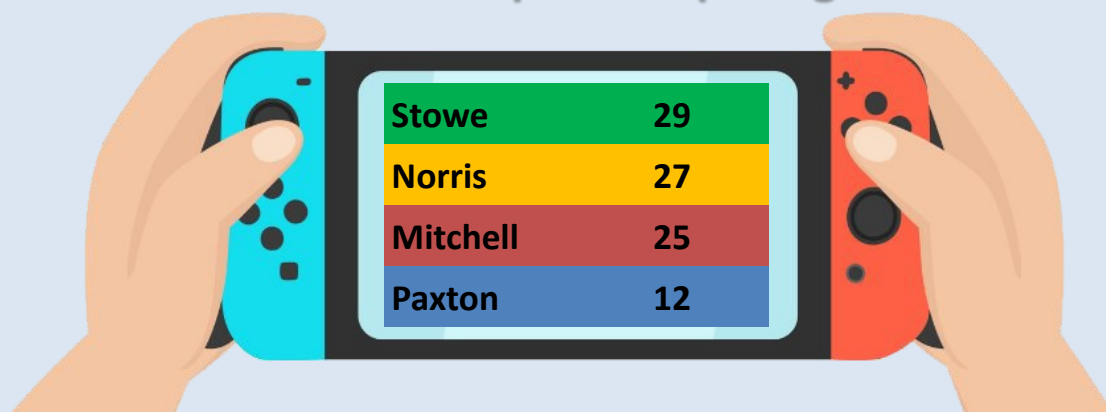

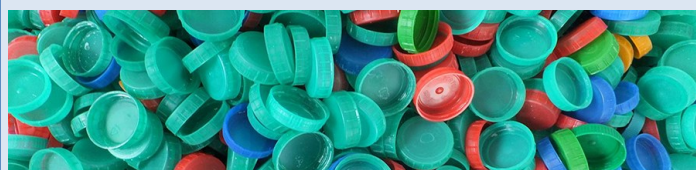
