As another way to reduce waste, our KS4 students are holding a Soup Kitchen on Wednesday 19th October creating soups using up left over ingredients and also baking bread. They have



Year 7 have been studying the painting 'The Starry Night' by Vincent Van Gogh.


I am incredibly proud of Anna B for her amazing attitude to Art, her work ethic and level of effort she brings to every lesson.
