Message from The Editor, Miss Barker

On Thursday 20th October, I accompanied Mrs Devine and Mr Doe, with a group of Year 9 students to The Sustainability Centre in the South Downs to look at food production.

We started the day with a tour of George Atkinson's 1200 acre farm. His family have been farming in the South Downs for many generations, initially they started as dairy farmers and now they rear cows and sheep for meat as well as growing a variety of crops. We toured the farm on the back of a tractor with a trailer which luckily had a roof as the weather was against us with very wet conditions however this was very beneficial to the farm with the dry summer we have had. Our students enjoyed stopping at various points around the farm and listening to George talk about the history of the farm and how farming works. Their land is very diversely rich with a variety of wildlife and insects living within their wildlife areas and hedgerows which they leave in place to improve biodiversity.



We stopped to take a look at their cows and learn more about where our food comes from and the quality, our students enjoyed meeting the cows and even got up close and personal with them. Both George and his son were very knowledgeable about the industry and it was interesting to hear about how it all works and the struggles they are facing with rising costs and machinery and technology replacing man. Sustainability Trip Continued...

Our students came up with lots of good questions for them both including some difficult questions to fully understand what it takes to work in this business.

We went back to The Sustainability Centre for lunch and some of our students enjoyed a game of football as the sun had come out. After lunch we were shown around some of the projects that take place at the centre and the benefits of growing your own fruit and vegetables. The centre is a hive of

activity with a variety of workshops for people to take part in all around the theme of sustainability and education set in a woodland area once owned by the Navy.



Our students had a go at planting their own seeds in pot they made out of newspaper to avoid using plastic pots. They allow you to plant your seeds directing into the ground after they have germinated as the newspaper will naturally decompose. They planted wild flowers and runner beans which will now be looked after by the class in Science and will later move into our Art and Sensory garden.

A huge thank you to Mrs Devine for organising the trip for our Year 9 students as it was a new experience for some of them as they learnt a lot about food production to aid their Science work in lessons.

Canteen Price Increases

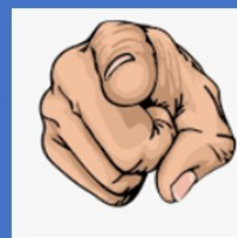

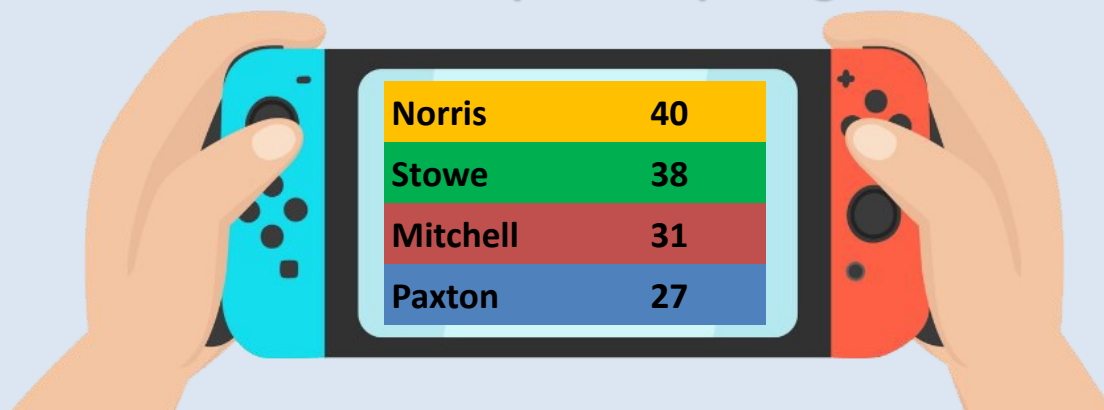

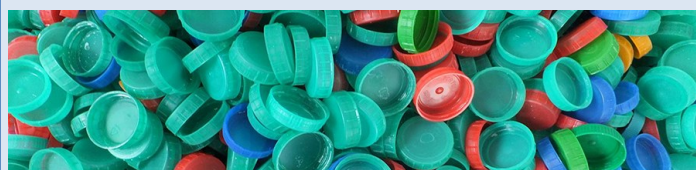
Milk Bottle Top Collection
