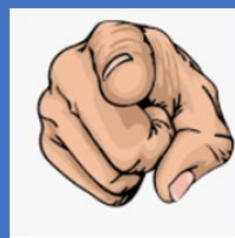

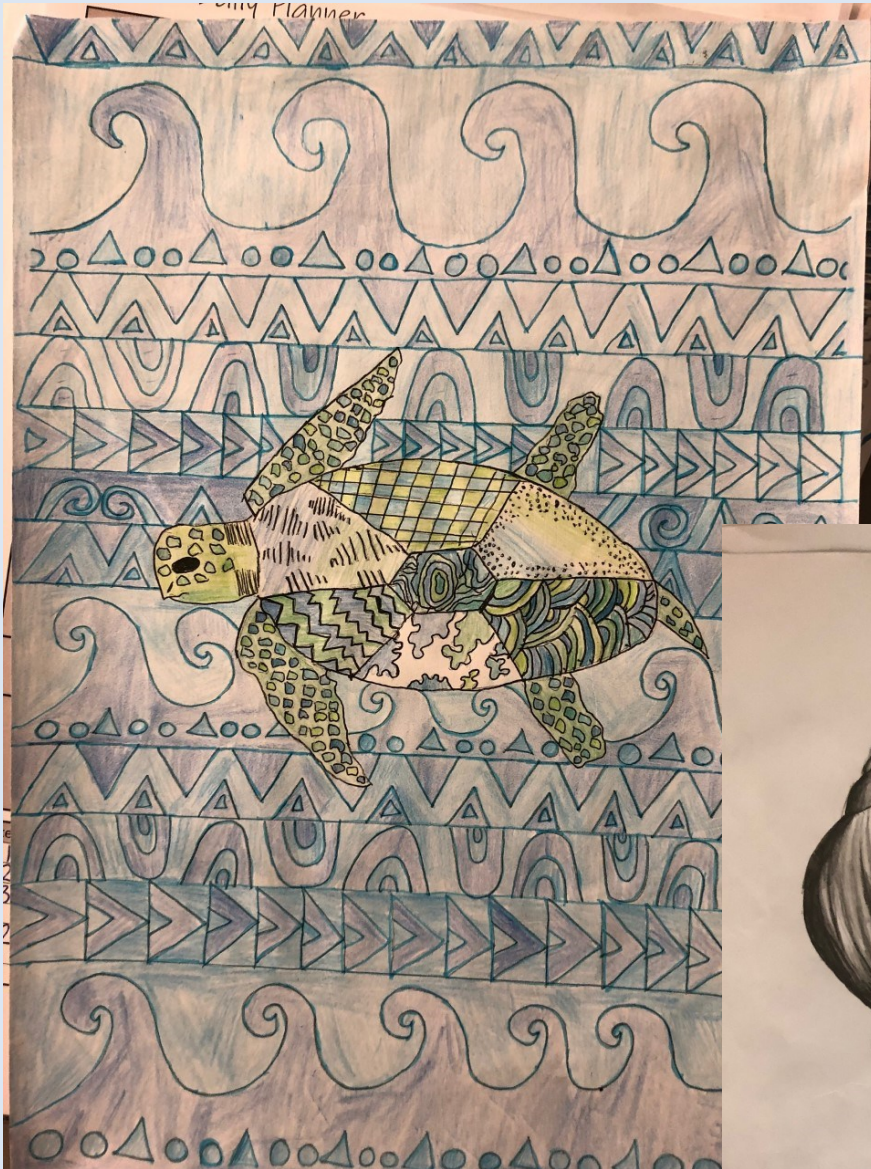


## Year 7 & 8 Artwork

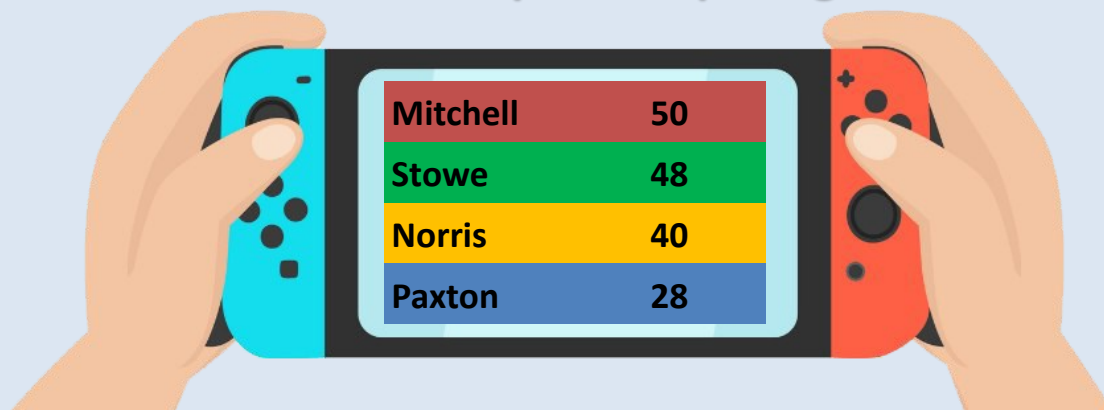

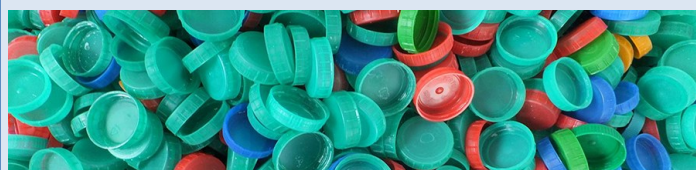
