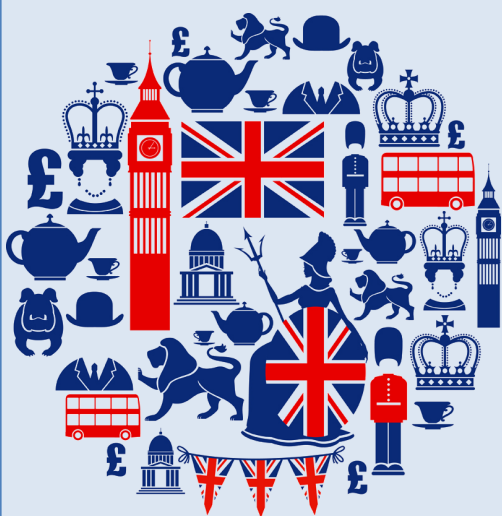
It has been a busy week for our Year 11 students who are currently taking their PPEs. Well done for your mature approach to these exams. Make sure you keep revising and try your best.

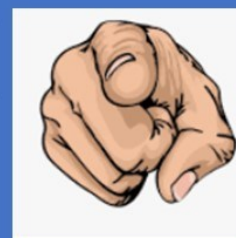

PE Star of the Week

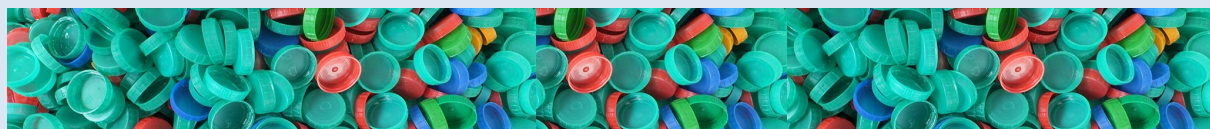
Sam P Year 9
