Our Catering Team got in on the action with these smiley red cakes made by Mrs Vince which were quickly snapped up at lunchtime!

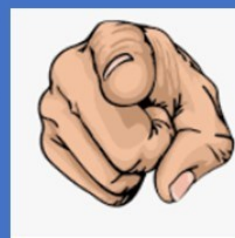
