'Leah S and Kacie D both attended the International Dance Organization (IDO) street dance workshop in Oxford last weekend with their Dance school. They were trying out for the European and World Championships and were judged by Kyron Anthony and Nathaniel SB Jones.

The girls have been chosen to represent Britain in the IDO Hip Hop and Popping World Championships in October in Poland. They will be competing as solo dancers along with several of their dance school friends and teacher from Southzone Dynamic Dance Company.

Leah started ballet at age two and by age five she was doing several styles of dance including tap, modern, hip hop and musical theatre as well as competing in local festivals singing and dancing. She moved dance schools to focus on street dance when she started in Year 8. She competed at the street dance International (SDI) Great Britain finals in London last July, which she qualified for after her first street dance competition in Portsmouth.

This year Leah has started focusing on popping and locking alongside learning some break dance. She dances three to four times a week and commits about six to nine hours a week to dancing.' **Mrs Stainsby, Leah's Mum**

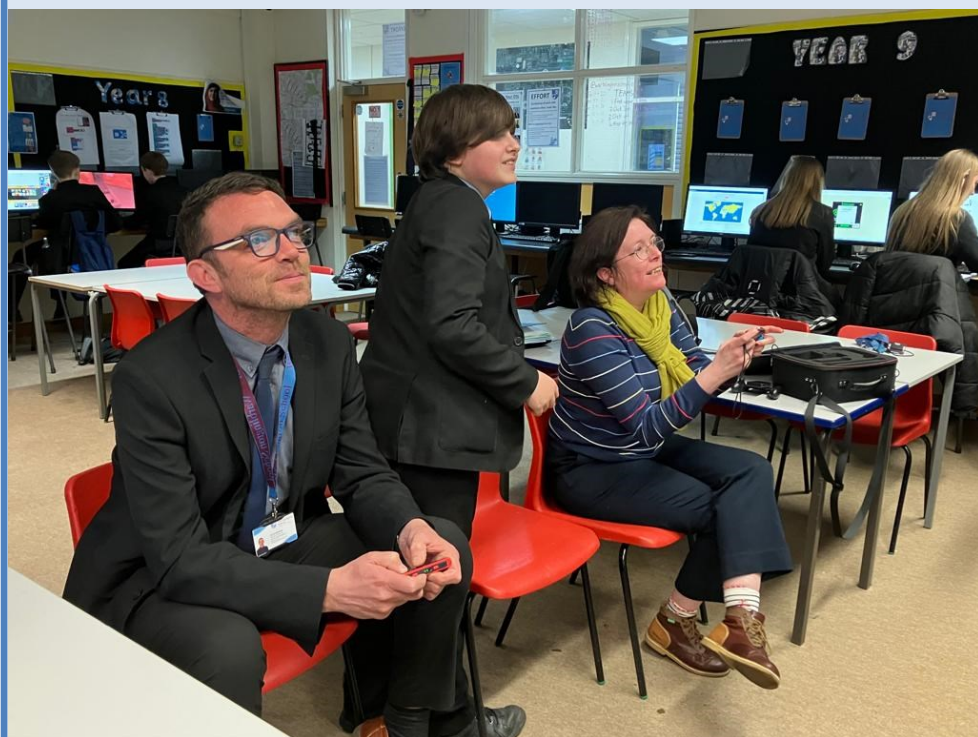

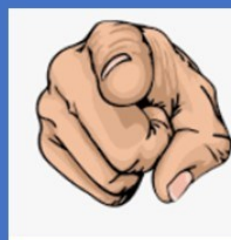

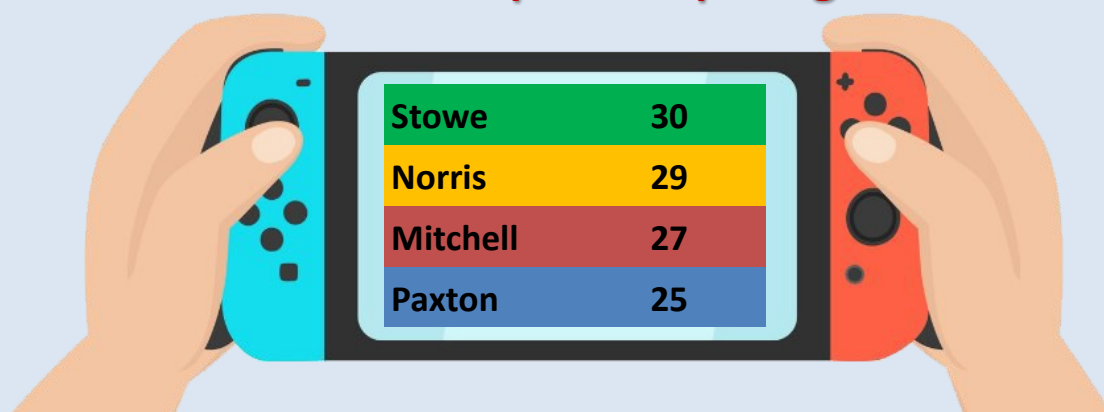
