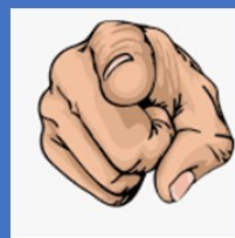


Year 11 Before and After School Revision Timetable

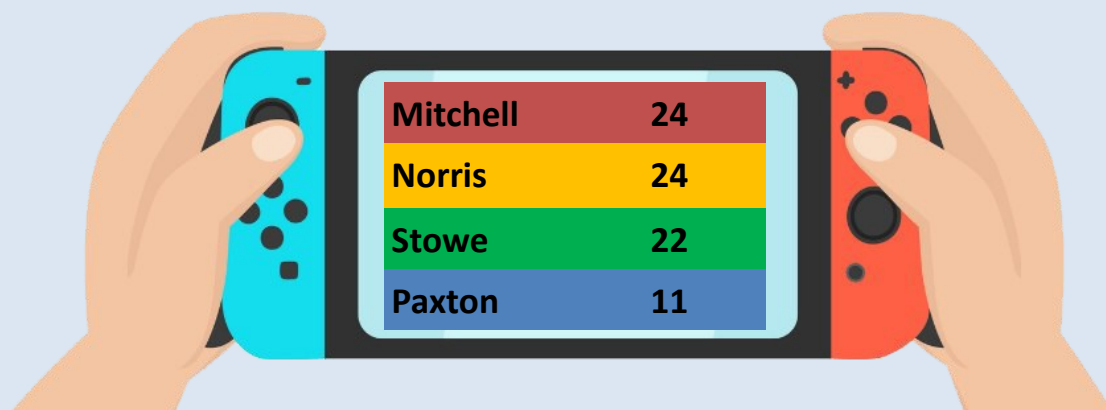


eSports Club Weekly Round Up
