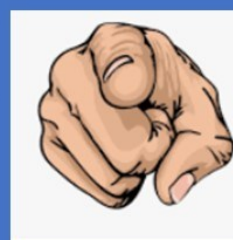

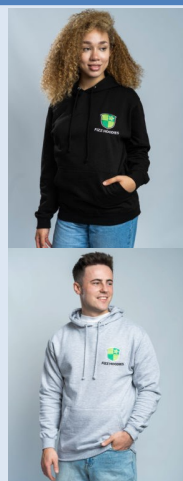

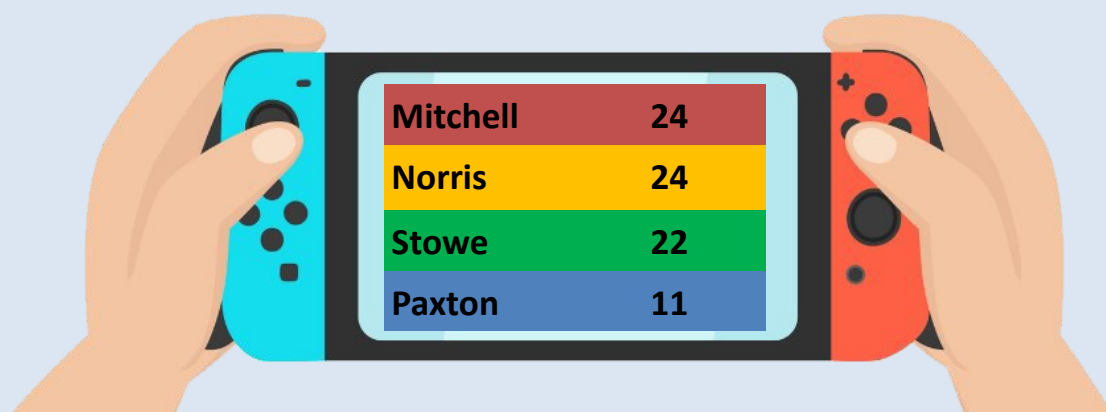


## eSports Club Weekly Round Up
