Industrial Action: Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July 2023

I am writing to confirm the arrangements for the next proposed national strike action days on Wednesday 5 July and Friday 7 July, and notification that we have rearranged our Year 6 Transition Day from Wednesday 5 July to Thursday 6 July. The changes to the Transition programme should not affect the normal working week for Warblington students, but will increase the numbers of students on site on these days. I should add we have tried to keep as many students in as we can whilst keeping the site safe.

Wednesday 5th July

Year 10 will be expected in as they have two exams on this day, Maths and English language. These have been rescheduled from Friday 30th, as invigilators are being used. This will allow normal teaching for Year 10 on Friday 30th June. Attendance is compulsory, and there will be short break in between to allow them to get some food. They will be able to leave site once the English exam is completed. This is likely to be around 1.00pm – however this may differ for those who have exam concessions.

Year 9 will all be in, following as normal a timetable as is possible.

Year 8 will be set some work on Classcharts and will be at home.

Year 7 will see half the year group in. We will be having the H half of Year 7 in, meaning if your child has the following timetable on that day, they will be expected in and will have their normal lessons on site.

Any remaining Year 7 students will be at home and will be set tasks on Classcharts on this day.

Friday 7th July

Year 9 will also be at home, with tasks set on Classcharts.

Year 8 will be expected on site and to attend their normal lessons.


