## RHS Wisley Gardens

On Monday a group of Year 10 students took part in a reward trip after being nominated by their Science teachers to thank them for their hard work, enthusiasm and good behaviour in Science this year. We visited Royal Horticultural Society Wisley Gardens where our students learnt about the work of the scientists at the gardens including research into how being among plants reduces stress and improves well being.

In a workshop they dissected flowers to see the reproductive parts, before going out to the garden trail grounds to see how horticulturalists selectively breed roses. The group acted as judges, scoring different characteristics of each rose plant. They then learnt about cloning to produce genetically identical plants and the benefits and problems of this. The group were praised by the workshop leader for their great behaviour.

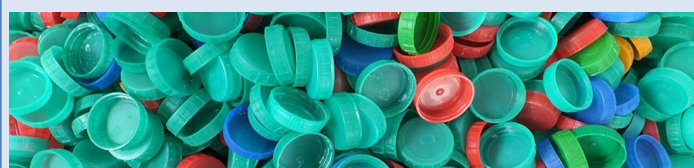

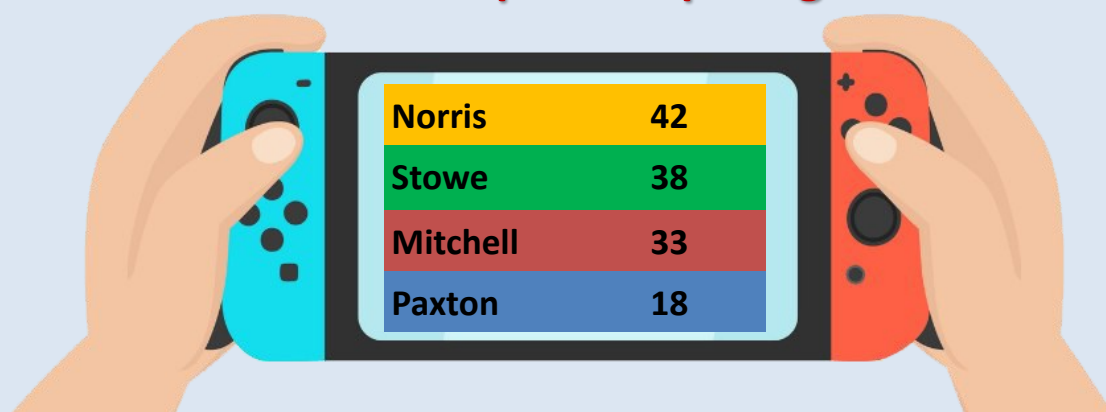
