Students that have been asked to be tour guides, please return the permission slips by Friday 22nd September.

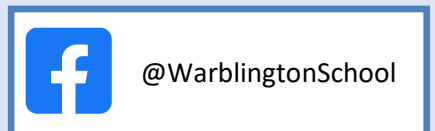
