## Success for Year 7 and 8 Mathematicians

Each year, approximately 300,000 Year 7 and Year 8 pupils from across the UK are invited to take part in the Junior Maths Challenge, a prestigious national competition run by the United Kingdom Mathematics Trust (UKMT). The competition encourages mathematical reasoning, precision of thought and fluency to challenge the highest attainers. Roughly the top 5% of all entrants nationally receive a Gold award, the top 10% receive a Silver award, and the top 25% receive a Bronze award.

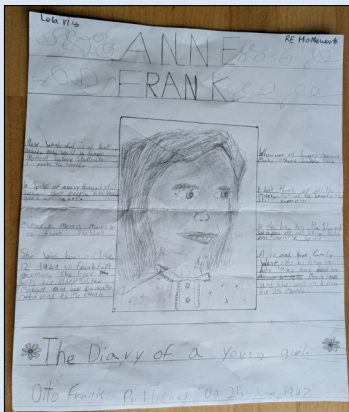
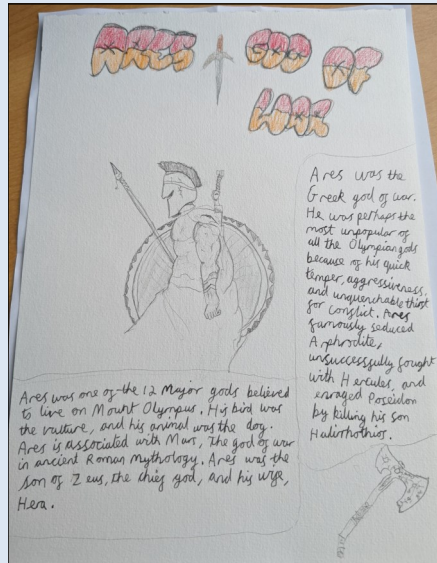

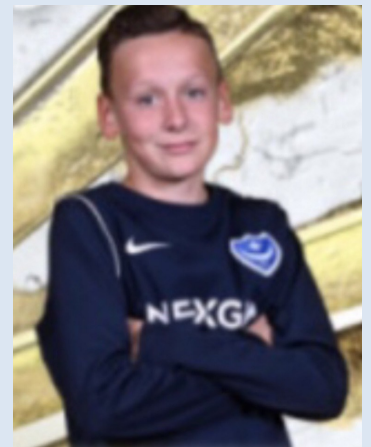
