Key Safety Features:

- Age Filters: Tailored responses based on user age.
- Parental Controls: Family Centre will soon monitor interactions.
- Content Moderation: Filters to block harmful content.

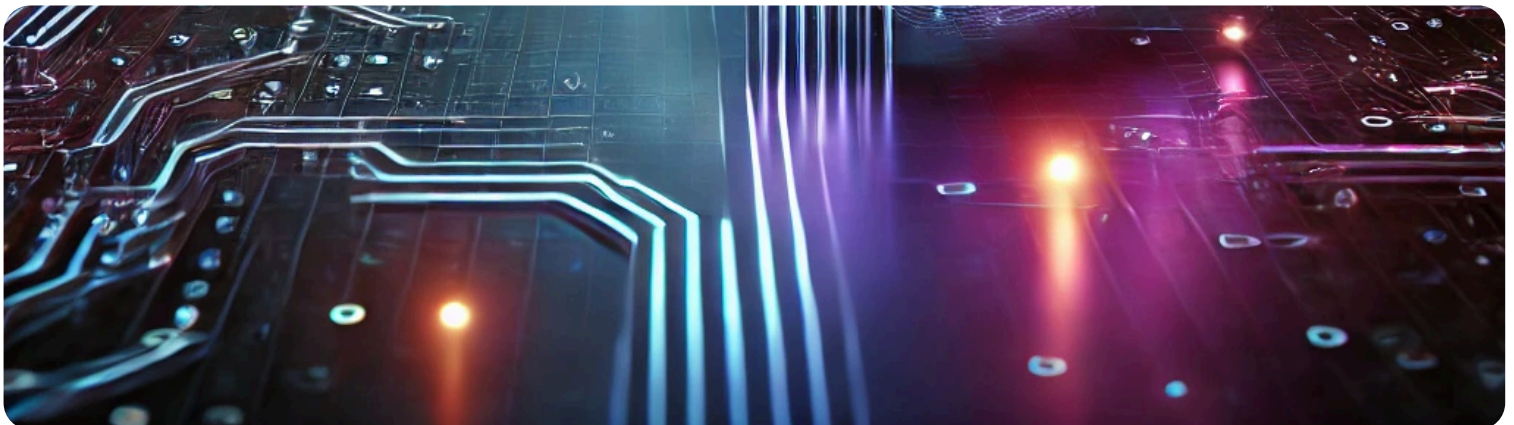
Parental Tips:

- Learn how My AI works.
- Enable parental controls when available.
- Discuss risks of AI and encourage sharing concerns.
- Teach safe usage and avoid sharing personal details.
- Report any inappropriate responses.

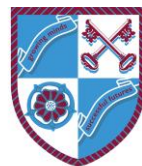
