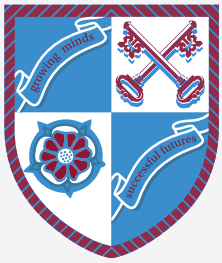

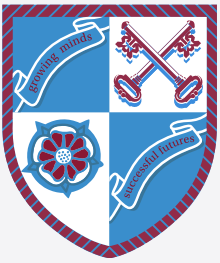

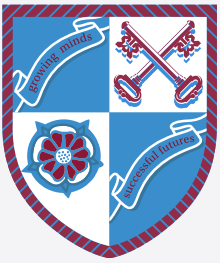
## PE Kit Donations Wanted

Roses will be available to purchase in the school hall from 10th February, with prices starting at just 50p!

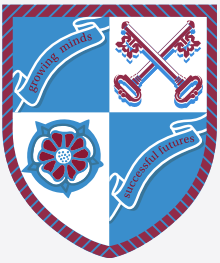

## Stronger Starts for Warblington School

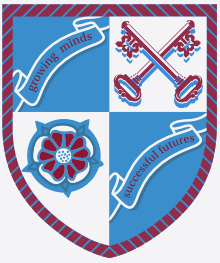
