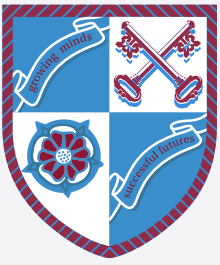

Stronger Starts for Warblington School

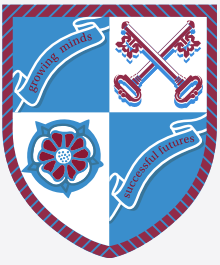
We're thrilled to announce our project has been accepted into the Tesco Stronger Starts initiative! Voting runs from mid-January to March 2025 in select Tesco stores.

PE Kit Donations Wanted

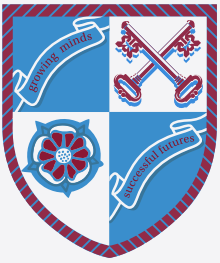
If you have any old or unwanted Warblington PE kits, our PE department would greatly appreciate donations! The kits will be used as spares for students who forget theirs or to support those in need.
