Planetarium

40 Year 7 students visited the Chichester Planetarium today. They enjoyed gazing into the night sky during the planetarium show. Afterwards, we had a talk on Meteorites with examples of where they had landed, including the lady who had bought her 1st car for \$400 on her 18th birthday and was offered \$75,000 for it after it was hit by a meteorite. The car has since been shipped around the world to different exhibitions. We also learnt about space junk left by humans floating around in orbit, including a Tesla sent into space by Elon Musk. The group travelled by train and behaved very well receiving positive comments from fellow passengers.

On Wednesday two Year 8 classes visited Lifelab at Southampton General Hospital. They took part in a range of health checks including flexability, grip strength, artery scans and blood pressure levels. They also extracted their own DNA and learnt how their healthy choices now can have an impact on their health later in life.






