
#### The activities may include:

We will keep our kit on site, but we will purchase another to place near our Defibrillator, which is located outside Reception for the public.

Warblington Blues:



This experience was a fantastic source of inspiration — we hope it encourages our students to stay engaged with basketball and continue developing their skills next year!








#### MFL Pen Pals!



All items are 50p and the sale will be in the canteen at breaktime, next to the stage.






