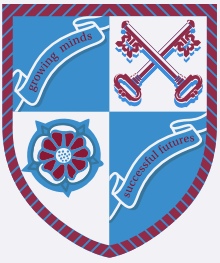

A massive thank you to Mrs Merrick for arranging this brilliant fundraising event! More photos are on the next page and our socials!



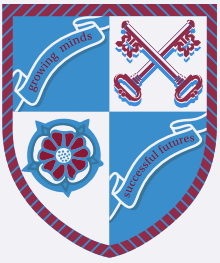
