- The route starts at Warblington School and proceeds down the Cycle path and then takes the route of the Billy Track, Alleyways, and shoreline, then returning to Warblington School.

- On Friday the 11th July 2025 Warblington School will turn pink for the third year running. Staff and students will be taking part in The Warblington Race4Life, raising money for cancer research. 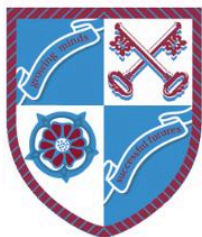

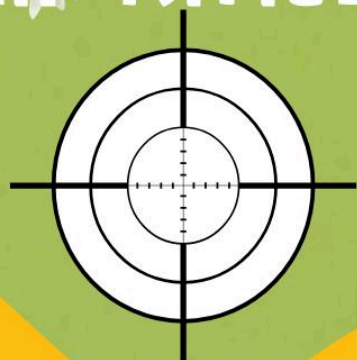

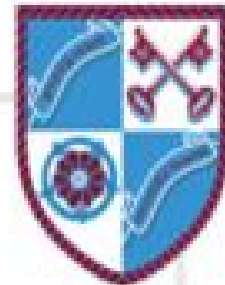
