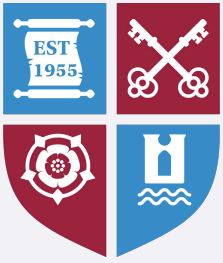

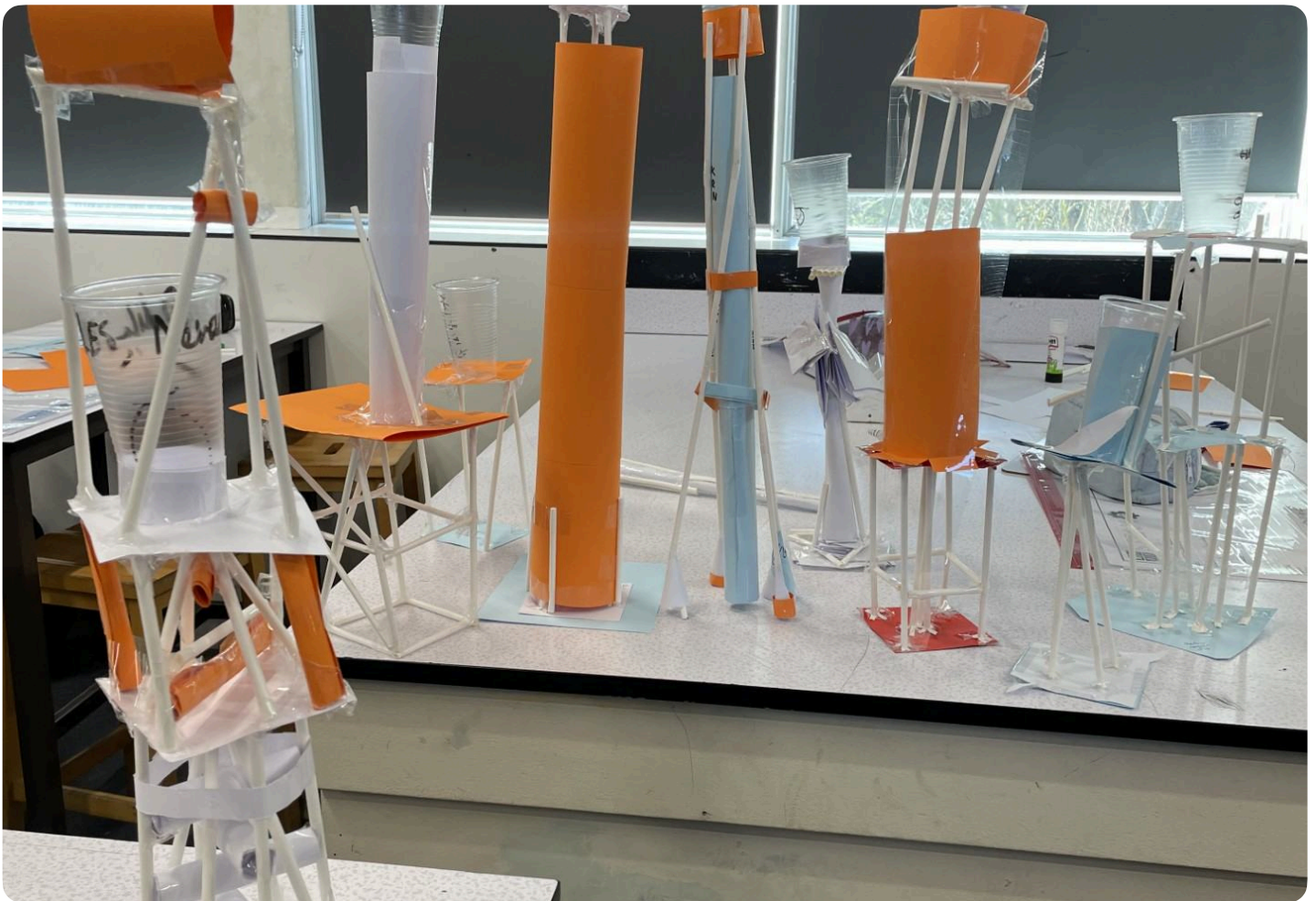
As part of British Science Week 2026, Year 7 had three lessons culminating with our 'best tower-off!'.

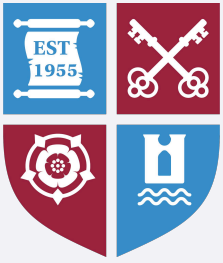
Students have been working for three weeks to design and then build a tower made from only card and/or paper and/or paper straws, so as to hold half a cup of water at least 50cm above the floor.
